Lack of protocols make moving to adult healthcare difficult 85% of youth with or without special needs

lack of training in HCT & AYA issues

failure to prepare teens for adult model of care

reluctance to leave pediatrician

lack of training in childhood onset diseases






Consequences of failed transfer to adult care for AYA with and without chronic illness



Missed opportunities for preventive health care



Disruption in services for AYA w/ special health needs















INSTEAD of TRANSFER, a TRANSITION.

It is "purposeful, planned and timely transition from child to adult model health care, with or without a transfer to a new clinician."

Benefits of Health Care Transition

- improvement in adherence to care
- improved self-care skills
- improved perceived health status
- improved quality of life
- potential decreased hospitalization rates and cost savings














Health Care Transition in the Philippines








Survey among Medical Schools & HAB-Accredited Hospitals

PERCENTAGE OF RESPONSES OUT OF 200 REQUESTS















TOPICS taught in Medical Schools & Hospitals? N=68

What are proposed adaptive solutions to LACK of INSTRUCTORS?

TOP 3

- Capacitate general pediatricians via lectures, workshops and post-graduate courses (f2f / online); faculty development programs
- 2. Hire OR invite adolescent medicine specialists to give lectures (f2f/online); assistance from SAMPI/PSAMS
- 3. Encourage residents to go into adolescent med fellowship







What are proposed adaptive solutions to LACK of MATERIALS?

- PPS to provide instructional design, materials and references on the PPS website
- Provide self –directed learning modules
 - Simplified TLA (teaching /learning activities); case –based discussions; use of simulations/ standardized patients; flip classroom with reporting
- Ask medical schools to share materials and references


